International contributions from South Africa and Eswatini enrich this issue through analyses of homelessness, mental health, family transitions, and inclusive higher education, fostering comparative discussions on social justice, well-being, and public policy. Together, these studies demonstrate the value of interdisciplinary scholarship in addressing complex societal challenges and advancing evidence-based knowledge across diverse contexts.
